



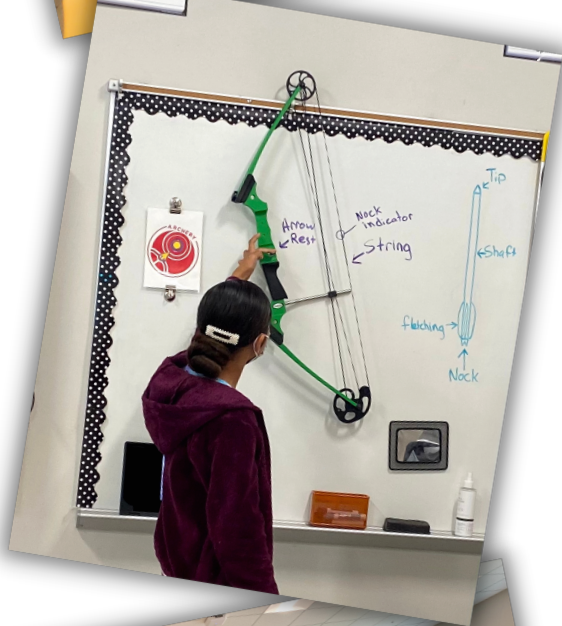
Online registration for all EL summer programs will be open March 22nd - April 22nd. Online application will be available on the Madison City Schools website or at each school through your child's EL teacher.
