2025-2026 Dance Tryouts

Who: Any upcoming 7th or 8th grader who is attending Journey Middle School during the 2025-2026 school year and is interested in being a part of the dance team.

When: -Interest Meeting will be held Tuesday, February 17 at 5:30 PM in the JMS Cafeteria.
-Clinic will be held Monday, March 9 (3:30–5:30) and Tuesday, March 10 (3:30-5:30).
-Tryouts will be held Wednesday, March 11 (3:30-5:30).
-Parent Meeting for the 26-27 team will be held Tuesday, March 24 at 5:30 PM in Coach Glasgow's Classroom (Rm. 229 Yellow)
-Uniform Fitting for the 26-27 team will be held Wednesday, March 25 after school in Coach Glasgow's Classroom (Rm. 229 Yellow)

Where: JMS Cafeteria (Interest Meeting, Clinic, & Tryouts)

Attire: On clinic days, you may wear any appropriate clothes that you are comfortable dancing in. On tryout day, please wear a white top, black shorts, jazz shoes (or flexible tennis shoes), no jewelry, and hair pulled out of your face.

To participate in the clinic and tryouts, each dancer candidate must have the following forms filled out in their entirety by March 9.

1. Sign up for Tryouts via the Google Form (Visit the link on our page of the JMS website).
2. Updated Physical Form (printed copy brought to Mrs. Day in Room 226 or Ms. Glasgow in Room 229).
3. Two Teacher Recommendations (These will be submitted through an online form, located on our page of the JMS website. You must send the online form link to your teachers and ASK them if they would be willing to recommend you.)

All forms should be complete by March 9. Failure to do so will result in a candidate being deemed ineligible for tryouts.

Elements of 2026-2027 Dance Team Tryouts

Required Skills

*Each of these skills will be covered at the clinic and tryouts. Do not worry if they are new to you!

Left Split Leap

Right Split Leap

Single Pirouette

Double Pirouette

High Kicks (left and right/front and diagonal)

Fan kick

Splits (left or right - must attempt)

Dance Routine

You will be taught a short dance routine at tryouts. Below are the specific categories that you will be evaluated on in your performance:

1. Stage presence
2. Technique
3. Memory
4. Rhythm/Movement
5. Overall Impression

Requirements for 2026-2027 Dance Team

Students/Parents & Guardians,

Please read the following requirements carefully. Failure to meet the needs could result in suspension or dismissal from the squad.

1. All dance candidates must be physically able to try out.
2. All dance candidates must turn in all required forms and paperwork by March 9, 2026.
3. All dancers must be a Journey Middle School student entering either the 7th or 8th grade for the 2026-2027 school year.
4. All dancers must maintain a 70 overall average in each subject area. This average must be kept in all classes in order to remain an active dance team member.
5. All dancers must be able to attend at least one clinic day before tryouts. We recommend attending both days to feel the most confident and prepared for tryouts.
6. All dancers must attend all summer practices and meetings, including UDA Camp (June 2-5).
7. All dancers must attend all chosen JMS football and basketball games and compete in local and regional competitions.
8. Dancers must attend all in-season practices unless a parent notice and valid excuse have been given in advance. All practices two weeks before a competition are mandatory.
9. Dancers must abide by the Journey Middle School Student-Athlete Contract (can be found on the JMS website under Athletic Forms)
10. Dancers must agree to abide by the 2026-2027 Spirit Team Demerit System. Dancers must understand that the accumulation of too many demerits can result in dismissal from the team.
11. Parents of dancers must accept all monetary obligations.

12. Parents of dancers must be willing to work a designated number of times in the JMS Concession Stand.

13. Parents of dancers must be willing to participate in a carpool to/from games, competitions, and camp.

- Other selected spring practices (some Mondays or Wednesdays 3:30-5:30)
- UDA Summer Camp at Tennessee Tech University June 2-5
- Practices every Monday and Wednesday 3:30-5:30 beginning in August or possible morning practices
- All home football games/selected away games
- Selected home basketball games
- Pom and Hip Hop Choreography practice dates (TBD)
- Competitions in December/January

Projected Monetary Commitments

Dance is an EXPENSIVE sport. Please be sure to review all payment details and due dates before committing to trying out. Once a dancer makes the team, coaches will assume parents are agreeing to monetary requirements. All costs are subject to change depending on vendors and circumstances. No refunds or returns will be issued should a dancer quit or be removed from the team. Monetary Expectations will be reviewed in detail upon making the team. Please note that there will be a number of fundraising opportunities that can assist in offsetting both team and individual expenses.
