

Registration will begin on May 1. Registration will be online and links will be publicized on each school's website. Anyone who cannot register online may visit the school's front desk beginning on May 1st.

The core courses will be offered as Credit Recovery options, unless the student does not qualify for Credit Recovery and needs to retake the entire course.

Career Preparedness, Health, Government, Economics, and Beginning Kinesiology are the only courses that may be taken during the summer, if a student wishes to keep some of his/her blocks during the school year open for other opportunities.

The following Credit Recovery options will be available through ACCESS virtual learning: English 9, English 10, English 11, English 12, Physical Science, Biology, Environmental Science, Chemistry, Physics, Algebra I with Probability, Geometry with Data Analysis, Algebra II with Statistics, World History, US History I, US History II, Government, Economics.

The following ACCESS courses will be available as Academic Opportunities: Career Preparedness, Career Preparedness A, Career Preparedness B, Health, Beginning Kinesiology, Government, Economics

# High School Summer Program (continued)

All courses, with the exception of Driver's Edand ACT Bootcamp, will be taken through ACCESS Virtual Learning, an online platform. There will be no refunds issued for any classes that a student registerts for. Students will need to physically come to the campus to take their tests, and to meet certain requirements of specific courses (Beginning Kinesiology, Health).

The last day to drop any summer school class without a grade posting to the student's transcript is June 9th, by the close of business. If a class is dropped on or before June 9th, no refund will be provided, but the grade will not post to the student's transcript. All other grades will post to the student's transcript at the end of the summer school program, regardless of student progress.

## **Driver's Education Sessions**

There will be 3 sessions of Driver's Education. The fee for the summer Driver's Education course is \$150.00

# **ACT Bootcamp**

There will be an online ACT Bootcamp course available that will be taught by a Madison City Schools teacher. This course does not earn students a credit, but will provide support to students who are planning to take the ACT in the future or who have taken the ACT, but want to improve their score. **The fee for the summer ACT Bootcamp course is \$150.00.** This course will run from June 9 - June 12.
