Liberty Middle School Archery Team Student Contract

It is a privilege to participate in the Liberty Middle School Archery Team. As a member, you are held to this contract for the entire school year. By signing this contract, the student and parent/guardian accept the responsibility in abiding by these regulations and the consequences set forth if they are broken.

1. General Guidelines

- Academic: In order to be eligible to participate on the Liberty Middle School Archery Team, members must achieve and maintain an average of 70 (C) in <u>all</u> classes. If grades fall below the minimum requirement to participate, members may be placed on probation, or possible excusal from the team.
- Attendance/Disciplinary: If a team member is absent without an excuse or approval for more than two (2) practices, or if a team member develops a disciplinary issue during school, between teammates, or coaches, he/she will be subject to probation or possible excusal from the team.

2. Dues

- One hundred twenty five dollars (\$125). This money will be used to support the LMS Archery team through equipment purchases and maintenance, replace parts, etc., as well as allow team members to participate in local tournaments and includes a team shirt to be worn at competitions.
 - **i. Fundraising:** We will hold one fundraiser in which every member is encouraged to participate.

3. Practice

The Archery Team will meet on Mondays and Wednesdays from 4:00 pm - 6:00 pm in the LMS
Cafeteria. Attendance of the participants shall be monitored throughout the season to determine
their participation status for tournaments. Additional practices may be called at the coach's
discretion with a minimum of a week's notice

4. Tournaments

• Team dues include entry fees for local tournaments. Dates and 'flight' times for shooting will be decided by the coach at a later date. **At no time will entry fees be refunded for any reason.** The team uniform (Team Jersey and Blue Jeans) will be worn at all tournaments.

5. Transportation

• The team does not travel together on a bus to tournaments. Parents/Guardians are entirely responsible for ensuring that their child arrives at scheduled tournaments on time and are responsible for them at all times, not Liberty Middle School or Madison City Board of Education.
