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## MEMBERSHIP

Students will have 2 weeks to accept admission, complete the new member forms located on this page, and pay new members dues.

New Members must pay a \$35 fee, complete the NJHS New Member Form, and complete 2 service projects. Dues will be used to pay for a National membership, membership certificate, a pin, an NJHS member shirt and support LMS service project(s)

Returning Members must pay a \$10 fee, complete the NJHS Returning Member Form, and complete 4 service projects. Dues will be used to host Induction and support LMS service project(s).

Failure to maintain the required student average (90 or above in each class), will lead to dismissal of the student and removal from the club.
