

## FIRST CLASS PRE-K Alabama's Voluntary Pre-K Program PRE-REGISTRATION

- First Class Pre-K programs are accepting online pre-registration applications for the 2022-2023 school year beginning January 15, 2022.
- Enrollment is open to all children four years of age on or before 9/1/22\* who are residents of Alabama. (Children who are eligible for kindergarten are not eligible for pre-k.)
- Enrollees must provide a copy of the child's birth certificate uploaded into the online preregistration site.
- Enrollees must provide proof of residence either a current utility bill or copy of a lease or mortgage uploaded into the online pre-registration site.
- Students must be zoned for Madison City Schools in order to attend the Madison City Schools First Class Pre-K Program.
- There is no registration fee for First Class Pre-K program.
- Upon enrollment, a child's immunization record must be provided to the program.
- No child will be denied participation on basis of income, sex, race, color, national origin, or disability.
