

ACCESS

An initiative of the Alabama Department of Education, the primary goal of ACCESS is to provide equal access to high quality instruction by partnering with local schools to offer courses online. All courses required for an Alabama standard high school diploma are offered through the ACCESS program. In addition, ACCESS offers 5 different foreign language and 11 different Advanced Placement courses. Students in grades 7 – 12 are eligible to take ACCESS courses.

Enrollment

Students are enrolled in ACCESS courses by their school counselor and are provided login information to the learning management system. Please contact the counselor regarding enrollments and course prerequisites.

Courses

All ACCESS courses meet Alabama Course of Study standards and are taught by Alabama Certified teachers trained in the learning management system.
