A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF MILITARY FAMILIES

WHEREAS, the City of Madison Board of Education seeks to honor Americans who are bravely serving in the United States Armed Services by being a military-friendly district; and

WHEREAS, the Board is committed to and supportive of its military-connected children and families; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that military children and families experience high mobility during K-12 education; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that frequent moves, family separations through deployments, and reintegration issues present unique challenges to military children and families; and

WHEREAS, the Board is committed to meeting the unique needs of all students and families, including those of military children and families; and

WHEREAS, Madison City Schools maintain primary liaisons who, after completing professional development, serve as points of contact for military children and families, identify and inform teachers regarding special considerations military families should receive, and serve as school-based advisors to a Student2Student program; and


WHEREAS, each Madison City School maintains a dedicated page for the Purple Star Program on its website that features resources for military families; and

WHEREAS, each Madison City School maintains a Student2Student program to provide peer support for newly enrolled and transitioning students.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Madison Board of Education that it offers its gratitude and support for all military personnel, their families, and veterans; and
