OVERVIEW:

- **Courses:** Credit Recovery and Advancement courses are hosted through ACCESS Online Curriculum (excluding Driver's Ed and ACT Bootcamp).
- **Testing:** All course tests must be completed in person on the Bob Jones High School (BJHS) campus.
- **Breakfast & Transportation:** Are not provided to students enrolled in summer school courses.
- **Refund Policy:** NO REFUNDS will be issued for any courses for any reason. Please ensure your schedule and course selections are final before registering.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

- **Register Online:** Visit the registration link to select your courses.
- **Submit Payment:** Payment for courses is required at the time of registration

CREDIT RECOVERY REQUIREMENTS:

- **Eligibility:** Students must have earned a final grade of **40 or higher** in the original course to be eligible for Credit Recovery.
- **Credit Recovery Guideline Form:** Students must complete and submit the Credit Recovery Guideline Form to enroll in courses

ACCESS VIRTUAL LERANING:

- **Rising 9th Graders:** Can only enroll in Career Prep courses.
- **Fast-Paced Learning:** Summer courses move much faster than the school year. Students must be diligent and maintain an accelerated pace to finish on time
- **Credit Options:** Available in both Semester-long (0.5 credit) and Year-long (1.0 credit) formats.
- **In-Person Support:** While the work is online, on-site facilitators are available at Bob Jones High School for face-to-face help.
- **Testing:** All tests must be taken in person at Bob Jones High School and proctored by a BJHS facilitator.
 - Monday – Thursday | 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM
- **Progress Tracking:** Students who do not make adequate progress will be dropped from the course by ACCESS.
- **Refunds:** No refunds will be issued for students who are dropped or withdrawn.

DRIVERS EDUCATION:

- **Fee:** \$150
- **Registration Opens:**
 - **May 1** | Madison City Schools (MCS) students
 - **May 8** | Out-of-District students
- **Course Requirements:**
 - A valid driver's permit must be provided on the first day of your selected session to participate.
 - Students are required to report to campus on the first day of class, from 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM.
 - Students who do not attend or provide a valid driver's permit on the first day will be dropped from this course.
- **Schedule:** Driving instructors will coordinate and communicate the specific days students are required to be on campus.

- **Fee** - \$150
- **Dates:** June 8th - June 11th | 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM
- **Attendance:** Students are required to report to campus for in-person instruction to participate in this course
