We are here to show you why AP 12 Literature and Composition is the right choice for senior English.

TOP TWO REASONS TO TAKE AP LIT

- · Save time and money by skipping college-equivalent classes!
- Ensure you are prepared for the rigorous academic demands of college!

SKIPPING COLLEGE EQUIVALENT CLASSES

- If you score high enough, generally a 3-5 on the AP Lit exam, you are able to skip some college literature courses and/or some elective courses (freshman, possibly sophomore, level).
- While many colleges offer literature or composition course credit for both Lang and Lit, some do not; however, most of those colleges will offer an elective credit for the additional AP course.
- Some colleges commonly attended by BJHS students REQUIRE that you take BOTH AP Lang and AP Lit exams in order to request skipping a college equivalent course. This means that you must sit and take BOTH exams not just take the course.

UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA CREDIT FOR AP SCORES

UA offers several possibilities for AP Lang and AP Lit students. Those who score a 4 or 5 on either test receive six credit hours, covering both of the freshman literature and composition courses. A score of 3 on either exam earns 3 credit hours, which covers only the first-semester freshman course.

If a student earns a 4 or 5 on BOTH exams, he or she will receive a whopping 9 credit hours, covering both freshman English courses, as well as an elective course.

UNIVERSITY OF AUBURN CREDIT FOR AP SCORES

Auburn's AP <u>credit table</u> for presents the following:

Score of 5 6 hours of credit (Engl 1100 and 1120)

Score of 4 3 hours of credit (Engl 1100)
Scores less than 4 receive no course credit.

This credit is for EITHER AP Language OR AP Literature not for both.

Auburn directs you to the Office of the Registrar to see if your scores merit course credit. Important links: Office of the Registrar and phone number (334) 844-2528.

NOTE:

You may earn more course credits than those listed above. It is recommended that you talk to the advisor for your program of study in order to determine just how much credit you might receive.

COLLEGE READINESS

- · College core requirements
- The majority of colleges that BJHS students attend REQUIRE literature and/or writing courses as part of the core curriculum for undergraduate studies.
- The average is 6 hours of freshman writing & composition for some form of literature survey class. That's 2 complete classes!
- And that is JUST as freshmen it does not end in freshman year!

The University of Alabama:

In the 2019-2020 undergraduate <u>catalog University of</u>
<u>Alabama</u> lists for Core Curriculum/ General Education
requirements that it requires "six semester hours of written
composition (FC)."

It doesn't end there. Students are also required to complete "six semester hours in 300- and 400- level courses, preferably in the student's major, approved for writing (W) designation. The (W) designation indicates that one of the conditions for a passing grade is that students write coherent, logical, and carefully edited prose..."

ENGINEERING MAJOR?

This is the same writing requirement in the College of Engineering Core Curriculum!
