All About the First Days of School:

Procedures and Routines



Coming to School

- The morning car line drop off is at the back of the school. You will use the South Entrance.
- All students go to the gym in the morning.
- The students are dismissed from the gym by grade level.

Lunch

- We kindly ask that you do not join your child for lunch until August 19th.
 ☺
- This allows for lunch procedures and routines to be taught without distractions.
- Please practice their assigned lunch number. This will be in their folder tonight.

Snack - Everyday!



- Please pack snack separate from lunch.
- Pack in a container or bag.
- Please send one healthy snack and water daily for your child.
- Students are not allowed to share their snack.

Daily Rest Time

- Please send a cloth mat.
- If the mat has a pillow or blanket it needs to be attached to the mat.
- Wash the mat when it comes home and send back on the next school day.
- Please do not send stuffed animals or toys.

Dismissal - tags and numbers

- Color coded transportation tags will be given the first day.
- Leave these Attached to their backpacks, please.
- We will escort the kids to the proper spot each day.
- Each child receives a car line number. Please work to have your child memorize this.
- Every time your child is a car rider, you need this number on your dashboard.

Dismissal locations

CAR RIDERS-

- Dismiss from gym.
- · Listen for memorized car line number.
- Parents need to stay in the car.

BUS RIDERS

- Grouped by bus SHAPE and escorted.
- Please have your child memorize shape and driver.
- VAN RIDERS- know your van name.
- <u>WALKERS-</u> know "front" or "back" door. Please work on memorizing address.
 - Again, all K students will be escorted by an adult to the correct place each day.

Staying In Touch

- Please check your child's daily folder each afternoon.
- Please check your child's classroom website daily.
- Each teacher will send home information to sign up for "Remind" text messages.
- School Messenger emails are sent to families who provided their email addresses. If you do not receive these emails, please contact the front office.

Money

- Label the destination for all money sent to the school.
- Send money in envelope or Ziploc.
- Checks must have Drivers License #

Dress Code

- Socks and tennis shoes are required each day.
- Skirts need shorts or leggings.
- Wear practical clothing.

Boys only will come on Thursday, August 8th.

Beginning Friday, August 9th, all students will assume the regular school schedule.
