

All you need to know about our Field Trip to Gullion Farms!!

Our trip will take place Monday, October 21st. Please make sure your child arrives to school on time. We will need to take attendance, pack coolers with lunches and put on our class shirts before we leave campus at 8:00.

What to wear:

Your child will be given their class shirt the morning of our trip.

Please keep an eye on the weather. If it is supposed to be a warm day, I'll have the students go to a stall in our restroom to take off the shirt they wear to school and put on their new class shirt. If it is going to be cold, please send your child in a long sleeve shirt and we will put our shirt on over the long sleeve shirt. We will not carry jackets on our trip.

Also, since we will be on a farm, please send your child in old tennis shoes, preferably velcro. (They will have to put their shoes on quickly after the corn crib.)

Lunch:

Every child must have a lunch in our cooler when we leave school campus (even if you plan to meet us at the farm). If you said your child is bringing a lunch from home, it needs to be <u>completely disposable</u>. Your child's name needs to be written on the lunch. Use a gallon size ziploc bag and a drink bottle that can be thrown away. Also, any utensils need to be disposable. We will not bring anything back with us except our pumpkins.

<u>Information for Parents planning on attending:</u>

To attend the trip, you must be an approved chaperone. To be considered an approved chaperone you had to fill out the field trip chaperone form and returned it to school with your name and required information.

You will need to come to school the Friday before (October 18th) or morning of our trip (October 21st) and sign the field trip visitor log. Then you will drive on your own and meet us at the farm. You will need to arrive before 9:00. You will need to have cash/check to pay for admission. The cost is \$10.00 for admission and \$4.00 for a pumpkin.
