For the month of March please eat meals as a family. During this time, there should be no phones, TV, or technology. The focus should be on conversation skills.

Reading: Wonders Unit 8 Week 2

Phonological Awareness Skill: Changing in the last sound in a word to make a new word; ex: change the /t/ in pit to /g/ to make pig

Phonics: Identifying the letter Yy and Zz and applying the /y/ and /z/ sounds in words

Sight Word: what, words

Vocabulary Words: country, travel, careful, purpose, content

Comprehension: Identifying main topic and key details

Math: Big Ideas Chapter 13

This week, the students will learn how to compare the height and length of objects. When we compare height, we use the words: taller and shorter. For example, the ladder is taller than the chair. The chair is shorter than the ladder. We use the words longer and shorter to compare length. For example, the table is longer than the placemat. The placemat is shorter than the table.
