Vocabulary Words: intelligent, local, neighborhood, routine, volunteer

Comprehension: visualization; identifying story elements- character, setting, and events

Math: Three-Step Sort

The students will learn how to do a 3-step sort:

- 1) sort by one attribute, such as color, shape, or size
- 2) count how many are in each group.
- 3) sort by amount.
