April Challenge:



Listen to your child read 10 minutes a day and keep reading to them for 20 minutes a day.

Reading: Wonders Unit 8 Week 3

Phonological Awareness Skill: Isolating and identifying the same sound in a set of words. (Ex: guitar, goat girl= they all have the first sound /g/.

Phonics: Review u, g, w, v, x, j, qu, y, and z. We will also learn about the digraphs wh and ng.

Sight Word: your, all

Vocabulary Words: distance, recognize, surface, challenge, space

Comprehension: Making predictions within a text/story.

Big Ideas Chapter 11

We will continue to focus on 2D shapes. We are learning to identify and draw: circle, square, rectangle, triangle, and hexagon. We will also learn how to compare shapes.
