April Challenge:

Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: Initial phoneme deletion

Phonics: applying u_e in reading and writing words

Sight Words: came, away, funny, pretty

Vocabulary Words: earn, encourage, guide, most, respect, still, though, will

Comprehension: Cause and effect; text features-punctuation

Math:

Big Ideas Chapter 11

We will continue to focus on 2D shapes. We are learning to identify and draw: circle, square, rectangle, triangle, and hexagon. We will also learn how to compare shapes.
