Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: Final phoneme substitution

Phonics: applying digraph 'th' to reading and writing words

Sight Words: Review all kindergarten high frequency words

Vocabulary Words: blossoms, match, surroundings, trembling, stuff

Comprehension: Main Idea and Details; Genre Knowledge-Fantasy

Math: Big Ideas Chapter 12

This week we will wrap up our instruction on 2D and 3D shapes. We will review all of our 2D shapes: circle, square, triangle, rectangle, hexagon. We will also review our 3D shapes: sphere, cube, cone, cylinder. We will practice comparing and differentiating between 2D and 3D shapes.
