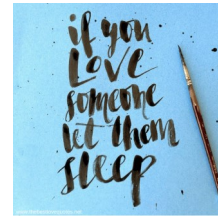

### Reading:

We will continue to learn about rhyming words. We will focus on writing our first name with the first letter capital and the rest lowercase. We will also focus on using correct formation and orientation to the line. Please continue to let your child practice. Handwriting is a great skill to practice one on one at home. ### Math

Rote Counting: 1-30

Counting, representing and comparing objects (more, fewer, equal): 0-5

Ordering numbers 0-5 in counting order.
