January Challenge:



Limit technology and spend more time playing board games or reading to your child.

Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: substituting initial sounds to make new words

Phonics: reviewing letters Oo, Ll, Rr, Cc, Ff, Jj and Ww and their sounds

Sight Words: have, are, one, two, three, and four

Vocabulary Words: scrub, talent, magazine, band, over, reason, culture, cactus

Comprehension: Identify and describe main story elements

Math: Big Ideas Chapter 7

Students will:

- Subtract a group of objects and tell how many are left.
- Tell what a minus sign means.
- Explain a subtraction sentence.
- Take apart a group of objects to tell the partner numbers.
- Subtract within 5.
- Use related facts to add or subtract within 5.
