Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: phoneme isolation and initial sounds

Phonics: short vowel e, k, and z

Sight Word: that, this, and there

Vocabulary Words: bay, collect, mirror, plain, strain, suppose, wrap

Comprehension: cause and effect, genre knowledge - realistic fiction

Math: Big Ideas Chapter 7

Students will:

- Subtract a group of objects and tell how many are left.
- Tell what a minus sign means.
- Explain a subtraction sentence.
- Take apart a group of objects to tell the partner numbers.
- Subtract within 5.
- Use related facts to add or subtract within 5.
