### March Challenge:

### Reading: Wonders Unit 8 Week 1

Phonological awareness skill: deleting the last sound in a word

Phonics: identifying the letters Jj and Qq and applying the /j/ and /kw/ sound in words

Sight words: were, this

Vocabulary Words: transportation, vehicle, journey, wide, fierce

Comprehension: making predictions and identifying the character, setting, and plot of a story

### Math

Rote Counting: 1-75

We will be learning about 2D shapes and their attributes. Students will be able to discuss the attributes of each shape and compare the shapes. The 2D shapes taught in Kindergarten: circle, square, triangle, hexagon, and rectangle
