Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: blending and segmenting sounds in words

Phonics: review short vowels o and e and using -ck to spell the final /k/ sound in words

Sight Words: all, good, say, my, and by

Vocabulary Words: chores, board, wait, equal, chance, moved, switch, follow

Comprehension: Identify common types of texts and their features, including literary, informational, fairy tale, and poetry.

During math the next two weeks, we will focus on 2D shapes. The students will learn how to identify: circle, square, rectangle, triangle, and hexagon. We will also learn how to compare shapes.
