Phonological Awareness Skill: Identifying, blending, and substituting sounds in a phoneme.

Phonics: Identify the long e sound in a word. (Ex: me, feet, Pete)

Sight Word: Practice and review all 50 sight words

Vocabulary Words: endless, experiment, perfect, similar, sort

Comprehension: Identifying key details in a text

Math:

We will spend class time practicing addition facts, subtraction facts, place value, and word problems. We will also continue to practice using: positional words (above, below, in front of, behind, beside), comparing 2D shapes (circle, triangle, square, rectangle, and hexagon), and 3D shapes (sphere, cone, cube, cylinder). We will continue to practice using our measurement vocabulary words for height (taller/shorter), length (longer/shorter), and weight (heavier/lighter).
