Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: blending, segmenting, deleting, and substituting syllables

Phonics: Ll, Rr, Oo (short vowel sound)

Sight Word: are, little, with

Vocabulary Words: base, grain, less, polluted, provides, recycle, replace, save

Comprehension: main idea and details

Math:

The students will learn how to do a 3-step sort:

- 1) sort by one attribute, such as color, shape, or size
- 2) count how many are in each group.
- 3) sort by amount.
