Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: syllable blending

Phonics: introduction of consonants m, d, and g

Sight Words: go, so, look, want

Vocabulary Words: back and forth, driver, horn, shut, through, town, wheels, and wipers

Comprehension: summarizing and main idea & details

Math: Big Ideas Chapter 5

- Your child will use partner numbers to make and take apart the numbers 6 and 7.
- Your child will name the parts and the whole.
- Your child will use a number bond to show the parts and the whole.

Important Information
