

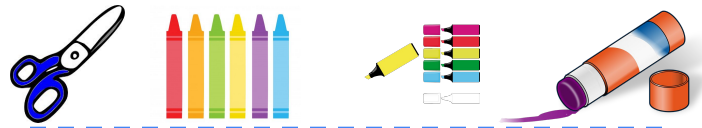

### Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: syllable, segmentation, deleting, and substituting syllables

Phonics: Review Tt, Nn, Pp, Aa (short vowel sound)

Sight Words: who, what, where

Vocabulary Words: warn, report, cozy, fort, pile, soft, stack, throw

Comprehension: Main idea and supporting details

### Math: Big Ideas Chapter 5

- Use partner numbers to show numbers to 5.
- Use number bonds to show the parts and the whole for numbers to 5.
- Model putting together and taking apart the parts to show the whole.
