March Challenge:



For the month of March please eat meals as a family. During this time, there should be no phones, TV, or technology. The focus should be on conversation skills.

Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: initial phoneme addition

Phonics: applying i_e in reading and writing words

Vocabulary Words: chores, board, equal, wait, switch

This week, the students will learn how to compare the height and length of objects. When we compare **height**, we use the words: **taller** and **shorter**. For example, the ladder is taller than the chair. The chair is shorter than the ladder. We use the words **longer** and **shorter** to compare **length**. For example, the table is longer than the placemat. The placemat is shorter than the table.
