Reading: Wonders Smart Start

This week we will be learning how to do Literacy Stations. Literacy Station time is their independent practice of skills taught during whole group. It is also when we differentiate instruction based on skills and needs of students.

Phonics: We will be learning about letters Xx, Yy, and Zz with our Letter Experts.

Phonemic Awareness: Isolating and identifying the beginning sound in words

Writing Focus: We will write our names with correct letter formation and line orientation.

Read Alouds: Rhyming Books - Listening for rhyme in books

Math: Big Ideas: Finishing Chapter 3 and Beginning Chapter 4

- Show, count and write the number 10.
- Use matching to compare the number of objects in two groups
- Use counting to compare the number of objects in two groups
- Compare two written numerals
