May Challenge:



Limit technology to no more than 30 min/day. Play outside daily. Get 10+ hours of sleep each night.

Reading: Wonders Unit 10 Week 1

Phonological Awareness Skill: Isolating, blending, and deleting sounds in a phoneme.

Phonics: Identify the long u sound in a word using the cvce rule. (Ex: flute, cube, mute)

Sight Word: Practice and review all 50 sight words

Vocabulary Words: decide, grateful, marvel, opinion, ragged

Comprehension: Identifying the sequence of events in a story.

Math:

We will spend class time practicing addition facts, subtraction facts, and word problems. We will also continue to practice using: positional words (above, below, in front of, behind, beside), comparing 2D shapes (circle, triangle, square, rectangle, and hexagon), and 3D shapes (sphere, cone, cube, cylinder).

Please decide what to work on at home with your child based on your child's Progress Report.
