January Challenge:

Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: substituting initial sounds to make new words

Phonics: identifying and writing letters Jj and Ww and their sounds

Sight Words: was, will, went, and jump

Vocabulary Words: define, exchange, other, decoration, filled, seals, hold, cracks, teach, tradition

Comprehension: Identify and describe main story elements

Math:

- Students will continue practicing addition using manipulatives to build a deeper understanding.
- Students will engage with number stories to strengthen their application of addition skills.
- Students will refine their ability to write accurate addition sentences.
