### Reading:

Phonological Awareness Skill: syllable segmentation

Phonics: review letters Mm, Dd, Gg, Ii, Ss, Hh, and Bb

Sight Word: black, blue, brown, yellow, no

Vocabulary Words: loop, opposite, rides, round, circular, great, track, matter

Comprehension: Ask and answer questions about key details in literary and informational text

### Math:

The students will learn how to do a 3-step sort:

- 1) sort by one attribute, such as color, shape, or size
- 2) count how many are in each group.
- 3) sort by amount.

We will use the M&Ms for our introduction lesson on sorting. Thanks for sending them to school!
