

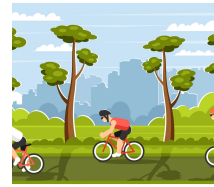

May Challenge:



Limit technology to no more than 30 min/day. Play outside daily. Get 10+ hours of sleep each night.

Reading: Wonders Unit 10 Week 3

Phonological Awareness Skill: Segmenting, blending, and substituting sounds in a phoneme.

Phonics: Review long vowel sounds: a, e, i, o, and u

Sight Word: Review all 50 sight words daily

Vocabulary Words: encourage, environment, protect, recycle, wisely

Comprehension: Identifying the main topic and key details of a text

Math:

We will spend class time practicing addition facts, subtraction facts, place value, and word problems. We will also continue to practice using: positional words (above, below, in front of, behind, beside), comparing 2D shapes (circle, triangle, square, rectangle, and hexagon), and 3D shapes (sphere, cone, cube, cylinder). We will continue to practice using our measurement vocabulary words for height (taller/shorter), length (longer/shorter), and weight (heavier/lighter).

Please decide what to work on at home with your child based on your child's Progress Report.
