



College & Career Readiness Requirement (CCR)


To be College and Career Ready (CCR), A student must earn a credential in at least one of the seven indicators listed below per Madison City Schools.

- 4 ACT Work Keys
- Military Enlistment
- 6 Career Tech Credential
- 7 Career Tech Completer

At least a Silver Certificate (score of 4 or higher on all subtests)






Criteria

Earn an industry recognized credential through a CTE academy.

Madison City offers more than 15 industry credentials through CTE academies. Check with your student's Career Tech teacher on the credentials offered through the program.

Criteria

Civics Exam

- All students must make a passing score on the Civics Exam.
- The Civics Exam is given through JCHS US Government classes (includes AP Government).
- Students taking US Gov or AP Gov through ACCESS must take the Civics Exam separately through a Schoology course online. The course code will be sent out to students junior & senior year.

Financial Literacy Exam

- All students must complete the Financial Literacy Exam.
- The Financial Literacy Exam is given through JCHS Career Prep classes.
- Students taking Career Prep through ACCESS must take the Financial Literacy Exam separately through a Schoology course online. The course code will be sent out to students junior & senior year.
