Registration: Invitations will be sent to parents/caregivers of students who are being invited to attend based on the highest academic need. These invitations will be mailed/emailed no later than April

14. The invitation will include a QR code and a link so that families can register their student(s) online. The program is designed to provide additional support and instruction on the critical skills in English / Language Arts and Math that are necessary for students to be successful at their next grade level. **The program will be provided at no cost.**

Each student will spend half of their day in a math class and the other half of their day in an ELA class. Teachers are highly-qualified and are Madison City Schools teachers.

High School Summer Program

Registration will begin on May 1 and will run through May 26. This program is designed to allow Madison City Schools' students the opportunity to complete classes that they have failed during the school year. There will be no cost associated with credit recovery courses or courses that students must retake completely.

Registration will be online and links will be publicized on each school's website. Anyone who cannot register online may visit the school's front desk between the dates of May 1st through May 26 to register.

Students who are not Bob Jones or James Clemens students **will not be allowed** to participate in the summer program (with the exception of the courses listed under Opportunities for Advancement and Driver's Education sessions)
