Assignments for both books, due the second day of class, are described below. READ CAREFULLY!

1 - Assignment for *Of Mice and Men*

While you are reading, use one or more of these strategies to annotate the book and include your thoughts and questions. **(This section is worth 20 points.)**

1. Write comments in the margin, especially to ask questions, relate to characters, make connections to your own life, etc.
2. Star any passages that are very important: events, decisions, or cause and effect relationships.
3. Underline any sentences that made you think or appealed to you.
4. Circle/highlight words that are unfamiliar.
5. Bracket areas that you were confused about or did not fully understand.

WRITING COMPONENT: After annotating, write a short narrative or script from the perspective of a character in the text, incorporating your annotations and insights. This piece should explore the character's internal conflicts and motivations, linking them to specific passages you annotated. Be prepared to share your narrative with the class and explain the choices you made. **(This section is worth 30 points.)**

Assignment Description:

Choose **one section** from *How to Read Nonfiction Like a Professor* and create a **multimedia presentation** that explores the central concepts presented by Thomas Foster. Incorporate personal reflections and real-world applications of these concepts. You will present your findings to the class and facilitate a discussion on how these concepts can be applied to current nonfiction texts or events. **(This section is worth 50 points.)**

Both of these assignments will be test grades and will be assessed on the following:

- Adherence to directions
- Correct grammar/spelling/use of words
- Depth of analysis/commentary
- Variety of elements and examples in multimedia presentations
- All text evidence should include correct MLA 9 citations
- No use of AI (**AI detector will be used on each assignment**)
