

Timeline

August 12th	This is the 1st day students from ALL systems will report to ACT – North AL campus @ 4104 Hwy 31 S, Decatur, AL 35603. If students from your school need to report to us prior to this day just let us know.		
September 27th	School Counselors & Career Coach Lunch and Learn. ACT – North AL Team will host the counselors and career coaches for lunch with a short presentation and tour. This will also be a time for any questions to get answered by school staff.		
September 26th	Parent Night (Current Students). Parents & guardians are invited to tour our campus and talk with our staff about the training and employment opportunities their student is taking advantage of. Details will be sent home with students.		
October – January	2024 - 2025 Student Recruiting Period . ACT – North AL Team will come to speak to all current 10 th and 11 th grade students. Preferably we will speak to entire classes separately for a 30-45 minute assembly style presentation. We are flexible and will do what works best for each individual school.		
January 16th	Open House/Parent Night (Prospective Students). Parents, guardians, & students are invited to tour our campus and talk with our staff about the training and employment opportunities available for their student to take advantage of.		
January 31st	2024 - 2025 Student Applications are due.		
February 20th	Student Interviews. ALL students that applied to attend ACT –North AL will be interviewed at our campus by our partner contractors. Students will be transported by the ACT bus/driver that brings current students which will not attend these days. If your school does not have a bus, one will need to be scheduled to transport all student applicants to our campus. If your school does not have an ACT bus this year, one will need to be scheduled to transport all student applicants to our campus.		
February 27th	List of Accepted / Not Accepted students will be sent to the schools. Letters for each student will be delivered the following week.		
March 27th	ACT – North AL Industry Day. Seniors interested in pursuing employment with one of our partner contractors will talk with those contractors during a career fair style event. Contractors will determine the students they want to interview for employment during this event.		
March 27 th – April 30th	Employment Interview Period . Contractors will schedule & interview at our site for those students that they requested during Industry Day.		
May 1st	ACT – North AL Signing Day . This is the BIG day when our graduating seniors will publicly accept an offer for employment with the contractor they choose to go to work for.		
May 16th	Last day for 11th grade students at ACT.

The Academy of Craft Training Student Absolutes

❖ Attendance Policy

- o 3 days no call no show dismissed from the program
- 8 days unexcused absences allowed, if a student exceeds 8 unexcused absences it will result in dismissal.
- o If a student falls behind 2 modules, they are subject to dismissal.

❖ Behavior Policy

- o 3 strike policy (3 write up forms will result in dismissal)
- Zero tolerance policy when disrespect is displayed toward authority which may result in immediate dismissal.
- Zero tolerance policy enforced with horseplay.

❖ Cell Phone Policy

 Zero tolerance policy enforced with smartphone/watch devices. All electronic devices must be placed in lockers once arriving at the center.

Dress Code Policy

 Students are required to wear pants, boots, and a belt. In addition, it is mandatory for students to wear the proper PPE daily.

Drug Policy

 Random drug tests will be given at any time. If a failed drug test occurs it will result in dismissal from the program.
