



# What is Dual Enrollment at UNA?

Dual enrollment gives students a head start on their education, easing the transition to full-time college while saving time and money. **UNA Early College** allows high school students to take college courses at the University of North Alabama, earning both high school and college credit simultaneously\*.

**\*Only Dual Credit Agreement Schools may earn both high school and college credit for their coursework. Students who are not enrolled at a Dual Credit Agreement School may still earn college level credit.**

## WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?


- Students who want to participate in UNA Early College must have at least a 3.00 unweighted high school GPA.
- Early College students must meet the same prerequisite requirements for courses that are listed in the UNA Course Catalog.
- Students who wish to participate in UNA Early College must maintain a "C" average in UNA courses.
- Students who do not meet the 3.00 unweighted GPA requirement may participate in UNA 105 – Strategies for College Success. Students must send an updated transcript to continue participation in the program after completion of UNA 105.

## WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF DUAL ENROLLMENT AT UNA?

- At the University of North Alabama, our Office of Admissions handles registration to ensure you're taking the right courses for you.
- Our Office of Admissions works to assist students with course selection, as well. If you have questions about which courses are best for you, our team will work to assist with course selection.
- Students who participate in Early College with a Dual Enrollment Partner school or district may earn scholarships for their incoming freshmen year at UNA.

REQUIREMENTS	AMOUNT
3.00 with 6 credit hours	\$1,000
3.00 with 12 credit hours	\$2,000
3.00 with 17 credit hours	\$2,500

*\*Students in Dual Credit Agreement districts only. These scholarships are awarded for one academic year and are nonrenewable. The Early College Scholarship is not stackable with some UNA scholarships.*





## HOW DO I APPLY AND ENROLL IN UNA EARLY COLLEGE?

**Current UNA Early College students do not need to reapply.** If you need to enroll for next semester's dual enrollment courses, you can complete a new Early College Course Selection form within your MyUNA account.

### 1. CREATE AN ACCOUNT

Visit [una.edu/apply](http://una.edu/apply) to create your MyUNA account. Select "Create Your Profile." Set up your MyUNA account using your personal email address and password. We do not recommend using school emails to create accounts.

### 2. COMPLETE THE APPLICATION

In your MyUNA account, select "Start a New Application" and select "UNA Early College" (dual enrollment) as your student type.

### 3. REQUEST YOUR OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT

Contact your high school counselor and request transcripts be sent to [ugalert@una.edu](mailto:ugalert@una.edu). OPTIONAL: Send your ACT Scores or subscores to satisfy core requirements for courses like English, Math, etc.

### 4. COMPLETE YOUR COURSE REGISTRATION REQUEST FORM

Access your MyUNA profile and scroll down to the "Early College Course Request Form" in the Additional Forms and Links section. Complete the form and insert Course Registration Numbers (CRN).
