#### STUDENT COUNCIL FAST FACTS

- Candidates must complete and submit their application to Mrs. Silk in Yellow, 228 no later than Sept. 19!
- Teacher Recommendations due by Sept. 21!

- · First Meeting: Tuesday, September 26th from 3:30-4:10 pm.
  - · You must have prompt transportation home.
  - · Attend bi-monthly meetings
  - · Participate in Student Council events
  - · Share/promote events in your assigned pod--more on that later!
  - · Be a student leader!

#### ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- · Everyone accepted into Student Council will be a "Representative."
- · 7th and 8th graders can run for the following positions:
  - · President (8th grader only)
  - · Vice-President (7th grader only)
  - · Secretary (7th or 8th grader)
  - · Social Media Manager (7th or 8th grader)
- 6th graders: this is your learning year! Next year, you can run for office.

## OFFICER CAMPAIGNS: 7TH AND 8TH GRADERS ONLY

- 1. You must be accepted as a member of the 2023-2024 Student Council.
- 2. You must be a 7th or 8th grade student.
- 3. Complete an "Intent to Run" Form.
- 4. Create a campaign poster for each hallway (7-8 total)
  - a. All posters must be approved by me--with my signature.
  - b. Only hang with blue painters tape.
- 5. Write a speech explaining which position you're running for, what you hope to accomplish, and why you're an excellent candidate.
- 6. Get your speech approved by me and create a campaign video!
- 7. All videos are due no later than October 10th.
- 8. Failure to complete any step will result in removal from the ballot.
