Constitution: The Latin National Honor Society will be made up of Latin students who have met eligibility requirements and have paid their current year dues. Dues will be paid to the sponsors of the club and deposited in the club account. All dues will be paid by the set time announced to all interested students. Funds will be disbursed based on the budget submitted and created by the club sponsors and all funds will be used for club activities or for promoting the study of Latin language and/or Roman culture to students at JCHS and the greater school district community. It shall be student driven with students working in leadership positions. The officer candidates will submit an application to a faculty sponsor by the announced deadline and will be placed on the ballot for election by Honor Society members. Meetings of the club will be determined as needed by the officers and sponsors. All activities will be planned by the officers, members and sponsors.

The JCHS Latin Honor Society has no affiliation with any political or religious organizations.

Qualifications for Membership:

- All members must be students presently enrolled at JCHS, but no student will be denied membership on the basis of race, color, creed, sex, national origin, or disability.
- Members must have completed 2 years of Latin study with an A average in Latin I
 and an A average in Latin II (not an average of the two classes), must be in good
 standing with national and state Junior Classical Leagues, and exemplify good
 citizenship.
- Students should maintain ongoing interest in Classical languages and studies and encourage others to do the same. All members must pay calendar year dues unless this fee is waived by a sponsor due to economic hardships.
- Each year until the member graduates, he/she must participate in Latin Honor Society meetings, participating in tutoring sessions, and being available for the yearly induction ceremony.
- Students must maintain personal and academic integrity throughout their high school career or risk being expelled from the National Latin Honor Society.
