









HOW I FEEL:	I NEED TO STAY HOME IF:	I MAY RETURN TO SCHOOL WHEN:
	FEVER: Temperature of 100.0 degrees or higher	Fever free for 24 hours without use of fever reducing medication (Tylenol, Motrin, etc.)
	VOMITING: Within the last 8 hours	Free from vomiting for at least 24 hours
	DIARRHEA: Two or more loose bowel movements within the last 8 hours	Free from diarrhea for at least 24 hours
	RASH: Body rash of unknown origin	May be readmitted with evidence of physician diagnosis and treatment required
	HEAD LICE: Active head lice with live bugs	Must be treated with proper medication and have no live lice. Parent must accompany student to school to be rescreened by the school nurse.
	CONJUNCTIVITIS (PINK EYE): Redness, itching and/or "crusty" drainage from the eye	After receiving a minimum of 24 hours of treatment
	HOSPITAL/ER VISIT: I have been in the hospital or to the ER in the last 24 hours	You have been released by a medical doctor to return to school; excuse should be provided upon return
	STREP, FLU, OR OTHER INFECTION: Diagnosed by doctor	May be readmitted with evidence of physician diagnosis and a minimum of 24 hours of treatment
