

PTSA Jets Service Scholarship Instructions

Purpose: The PTSA Jets Service Scholarship honors the outstanding service and accomplishments of one JCHS Senior each year with recognition at Senior Awards Night and a cash award of \$500. This award will be paid to the institution of the award-winner's choice (after providing evidence of school registration) to help defray the expenses associated with tuition and fees for scholastic endeavors or professional training.

Criteria and Eligibility: The award-winner will be a current JCHS Senior who is preparing to transition from high school to pursue further academic or technical instruction.

1. Minimum 3.0 GPA—provide copy of unofficial transcript
2. 40 hours of documented Community Service over 4 years of High School
3. Participation in 3 extra-curricular activities over 4 years of High School (school clubs, church outreach, or even part-time work)
4. 2 Teacher Recommendations
5. 500-word essay on community service

Categories and Scoring Components:

GPA (on unofficial transcript)	5 points
Community Service	10 points
Extra-curricular activities	10 points
Essay	15 points
2 Teacher Recommendations	10 points (2 letters x 5 points each)
Total	50 points
