

Madison City Council of PTAs Scholarship Information



The Madison City Council of PTAs awards scholarships, an equal number per high school in the Madison City district, provided such schools are in good standing with the Madison City Council of PTAs and the Alabama PTA. Scholarships are awarded to Madison City Schools graduating seniors who plan to pursue higher education through an accredited vocational or technical school or a degree from an accredited community college or four-year college.

Scholarship funds will be dispersed directly to the educational institution of attendance for the school year following their award. Should a winning applicant elect not to pursue higher education in the semester immediately following their award or transfer institutions after the scholarship funds have been paid, then the scholarship funds will be forfeited and returned to the scholarship program of Madison City Council of PTAs.

Requirements for Application:

- Graduating senior from either Bob Jones High School or James Clemens High School
- Attending an accredited technical school or college
- A current member of their school's PTSA (You can join at any time.)
- Overall GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Completed application
- Personal statement: Up to two pages, typed, double-spaced in 12-point Times New Roman font.
Describe:
 - Yourself
 - How your high school has prepared you for higher education
 - Your educational and career goals
 - Plans on how you would use this scholarship money to further your education
- At least one letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor
- Transcript (copies are sufficient for application, winners will need to provide official transcript)
- (Optional) Attach student resume detailing extracurriculars, work and/or volunteer experience

Submission Options:

You may either submit your Scholarship Packet (including all of the above required documents) to your school counselor (by March 27) or mail (postmarked by March 23) your Scholarship Packet to the address below:
